What Must You Do To Be Saved?

In order to receive salvation, you must first recognize that you need Jesus and He is the only one that can save you.

Romans 3:23

For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

We have all sinned and have fallen short of God's provision of glory, however no sin is too big for God to forgive. He is ready, willing and able to forgive.

Romans 6:23

For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

When you are not in covenant with God, you are working for Satan (sin) and the only wages he is able to pay is death but if you get into a relationship with God, he gives you eternal life through Jesus.

Romans 5:8

But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

God loves us, and while we were yet sinners (enemies of God), He extended His son Jesus to bring us back into a relationship with Him.

Romans 10:9-10, 13

That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

Faith is activated and released by the words of your mouth. So with your mouth, make a confession acknowledging or agreeing with God that you are not perfect and you need a savior.

2 Corinthians 5:17

Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

When you get saved, inwardly you become a new creation. Your spirit man is now alive because it is connected with God and God begins the transformation process in your life.

Matthew 5:6-7

Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled. Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy.

God knows that life has troubles built into it and that none of us are perfect. It is for this reason, He has given us a contingency plan through Salvation known as grace and mercy.

And finally, you must **REPENT** unto God for your sins, **BELIEVE** He is your Savior and you shall **RECEIVE** the gift of Salvation. That's it! Salvation is not a mystical process. It is designed to connect you to your first love, Jesus Christ.

YOU NEED TO:

ATTEND CHURCH Church attendance is not only a commandment of God, but it is also a necessity for Christian growth.

IMITATE CHRIST Disciple means imitator. Jesus is your example. Study the way He does things, and strive to be like Him.

SINCERITY IS THE KEY TO FREEDOM Be honest with God about your frailties while actively trusting Him to make you into what you need to be.

ENDURE THROUGH HARD TIMES Be patient with yourself. If you fall, follow 1 John 1:9 and keep going in the Lord.

SAY SO Tell somebody about what God has done in your life. Witnessing strengthens your faith. Philemon 1:6.
